Hi everyone

My proposal would be for one week the IEC students would have access to the Therapy dog and their volunteer trainer to be used in the classrooms in IEC 1, IEC 2 and IEC 3 plus in the SC 09 for certain students to access or take the dog for a walk or be exposed to the benefits of animal therapy.

This would be organised on a rotational, needs basis between recess and lunch on a Friday.

The following week the Therapy Dog and provided volunteer team member would be based in the Waratah or Banksia Room. A roster could be organised for students to access the dog, go for a walk or provide the appropriate therapy for either individual or small groups of students.

I would like some individual students to have access at some stage and he has student lesson 5, followed by SD time on a Friday.

The costing would equate to \$300 for term 1 and 2 plus \$75.00 per visit which would total \$750.00 a term.

The total cost could be split between Learning support, maybe Wellbeing and the IEC.

I have tried to contact the therapy organisation today to ask whether the Governing Council have to give their consent however I have had no response as yet.

Please let me know if you have any further questions or ideas on how we could implement the Therapy Dog Program into our learning environment to support the wellbeing and learning engagement of our students.

Mental Health Support Worker

On Friday, February 10th we were notified that we have been invited to be part of the new School Mental Health Service. The service was announced by the minister on Friday. The School Mental Health Service has been established to help support the increasing number of students who experience mental health concerns that impact on their wellbeing and learning. It is designed to complement – not duplicate – the range of existing mental health and wellbeing services already available in schools, including Student Wellbeing Leaders, Student Support Services and SWISS. The Mental Health Practitioners will be based in up to 65 schools to support young people with mild to moderate and emerging mental health concerns. They will be managed by a new team in Student Support Services that will provide appropriate clinical governance and supervision.

In practice, this means we will have a 1.0 FTE practitioner (may be from any discipline such as social work, OT, psychology) at our school for 2 years. They are unsure what will happen at the end of this tenure. It is not expected to start until term 2 at the earliest – possibly term 3.

Our school's involvement in the School Mental Health Service is voluntary. It will require an investment of time from our leadership team to set it up for success. Gerri will discuss this with the Governing Council on Tuesday evening.

Meeting structure

A large majority of us believed that it would be best to try this out and see how much more work we get done having two working meetings to do things. We are keeping everything documented this year on teams, each project we are working on such as sports day has its own plan which keeps track of what we are doing and what we have to do, when and how and who it involves.

Sports day

Goals for this year

- Continuing on from last year, one of our main goals this year is providing shelters on the northern and eastern oval for student use during break times and outside work during lessons. This has been highly requested from the student body. Long term project as it will require a lot of time, planning and funds.
- Water fountains. They were supposed to be installed over the Christmas holidays however this did not happen. The plan for one big expensive multipurpose fountain on the eastern oval and two smaller basic fountains has changed as the more expensive one is not refrigerated and there is no definitive location to put it. We are now looking at three basic fountains to be installed fairly soon around change rooms, quads, and possibly near open space.
- **Blue gums.** When the weather cools down hopefully we can whipper snip the paths down and then look at getting a quote on continuing the gravel path around the whole track. Later in the year.
- Increasing the promotion of SRC to the school body, more public speaking at assemblies and interactions with students regarding the work we do.

Good News/Thanks/Positive Stories

• IEC Playground and Lawn

The playground equipment has been installed. This week, three of our groundspersons worked with some students form the Inclusive Education Centre and the Young Environmentalist to lay the lawn in the playground.

It was fantastic for the IEC Students and Young Environmentalists Program participants to be involved in all aspects of the planning and installation process. Students developed an understanding for landscape design, map reading and measurement, including the financial costing of the project whilst experiencing the 'hands on' practical element of laying roll out turf - skills they can use in the future.

• Splash Day for Years 7 and 8 – This was held on Wednesday afternoon of week 2 and was really enjoyed by all of the students.

• Barossa Foundation ongoing support

Foundation Barossa has been successful in an application to participate in the Foundation for Regional & Rural Renewal Back to School Program. In addition to valued support from FRRR, we also received sponsorship from Barossa Real Estate.

The program operates through the distribution of vouchers with a face value of \$50 each to help the families in greatest need in the community, and distribute vouchers, one per student, to support their return to school in 2023.

This year the vouchers are for Kmart. They allocated 256 vouchers to Nuriootpa High School, valued at \$12,800 in this year's program and & 38 vouchers to the Flexible Learning Unit Nuriootpa High School, valued at \$1,900 in this year's program.

They have also just picked up the latest batch of computers from Yalumba as part of the Yalumba Computer donation program. They have 6 for NHS and 2 for FLO.

The Year 12s had a good day with the scene being set for 2023.
- All year levels returned on Tuesday January 31 and the school got bigger! It was a good first day
 with an extended Home Group and then straight into lessons.

Staffing Update for 2023

We started the school year with a full complement of staff – this is a very positive outcome and allowed a smooth start to the year. Tanya Bowley is acting as HASS/Languages leader behind Giles Bartram. Sue Brown is backfilling Tanya.

New Mobile Phone Policy to be implemented in 2023

We are currently looking at the new phone policy and how we will implement it at our school. We are exploring what other large schools are doing to learn from them. I have had some great conversations with students about how to implement it and they have raised some great questions. We will discuss this at the meeting.

Site Improvement Plan (SIP) for 2023 -2024

We have had our SIP for 2023, based on the progress against the 2022 SIP, approved. We have narrowed the focus to Reading for the whole school based on High Impact Teaching Strategies and the John Munro Reading strategies. We have identified a focus area for each term:

- Term 1 Differentiated Teaching need to continue with this from 2022
- Term 2 Questioning
- Term 3 Feedback to students and from students
- Term 4 Summarising

We are asking the Maths faculty to use the same strategies but apply them to Numeracy.

As we undertake the work in each of these areas, we will develop agreed actions for teachers and document them in Whole School Pedagogical Approach to address the External School Review Direction of 'Develop a collective understanding of high impact teaching strategies that support effective differentiated teaching and learning that supports all learners.' We will Also discuss this at our meeting.
