Please do not purchase iPads, Android and Chromebook devices as they are not supported on our school network.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

MacOS devices

MacOS devices do not have all the same software availability as a Windows device. As the NHS network is predominately Windows based, please take this into consideration when buying a device.

MacOS users may have to find alternative software to what Windows users may be using in the classroom.
