Career Pathways
Automotive Technicians inspect, service and repair motorised vehicles and equipment. The majority of work is the regular inspection, service and maintenance of what is commonly known as 'log book servicing'. Technicians diagnose faults and make the appropriate repairs. There are various ways to become an Automotive Technician: The most common way is to apply for a job (apprenticeship) at an Automotive Retail, Service and Repair business. Another common way is to complete some studies at TAFE first, in what is generally known as a Pre-vocational course. It is a full time, Certificate II level course. Many who successfully complete this course find full time employment as an apprentice.
